



Museum and Ship Rentals 2011

- Receptions start at or after 5:00 p.m.
 - Typical receptions run for three hours (extra time would come with an extra charge)
 - Shore bathrooms are available
 - Drinks and food can be taken on the ship
 - “Below Decks” of the *Niagara* are off-limits at all times
 - The ship does have a waterproof awning in case of rain

1. The “Plaza” (concrete area behind the museum) rate is **\$500** when *Niagara* is NOT in port throughout the 2011 season (early May until the second week of September). A tent may be erected on the Plaza. We charge \$800 for the use of our two 20x40 tents with side partitions.
 2. The “Plaza” rate combined with the museum’s interior is **\$750** when *Niagara* is NOT in port throughout the 2011 season.
 3. The ship is in port the following weekday evenings: **\$1,200**
